 - Funding is required for reconstruction, remodel, or building facilities in identified locations
 - Begin late Fall 2023

 The City Library's services and spaces will expand as a values-driven economic development partner, aligned with Salt Lake City growth.

 The City Library will provide the civic infrastructure—the places, policies, programs, and practices to build community connection and foster equitable and inclusive communities
