2100 South Closure Information

- The 2100 South Road Reconstruction project underway in Sugar House requires westbound-only traffic for two blocks from June 17 until mid-August.
- The eastbound lane between 900 and 1100 East will be closed for construction crews; westbound traffic will continue as usual.
- Highland Drive has been temporarily opened back up to two-way traffic to make it easier to access local businesses.

- Provide feedback regarding streetlighting at any location in the city via the survey;

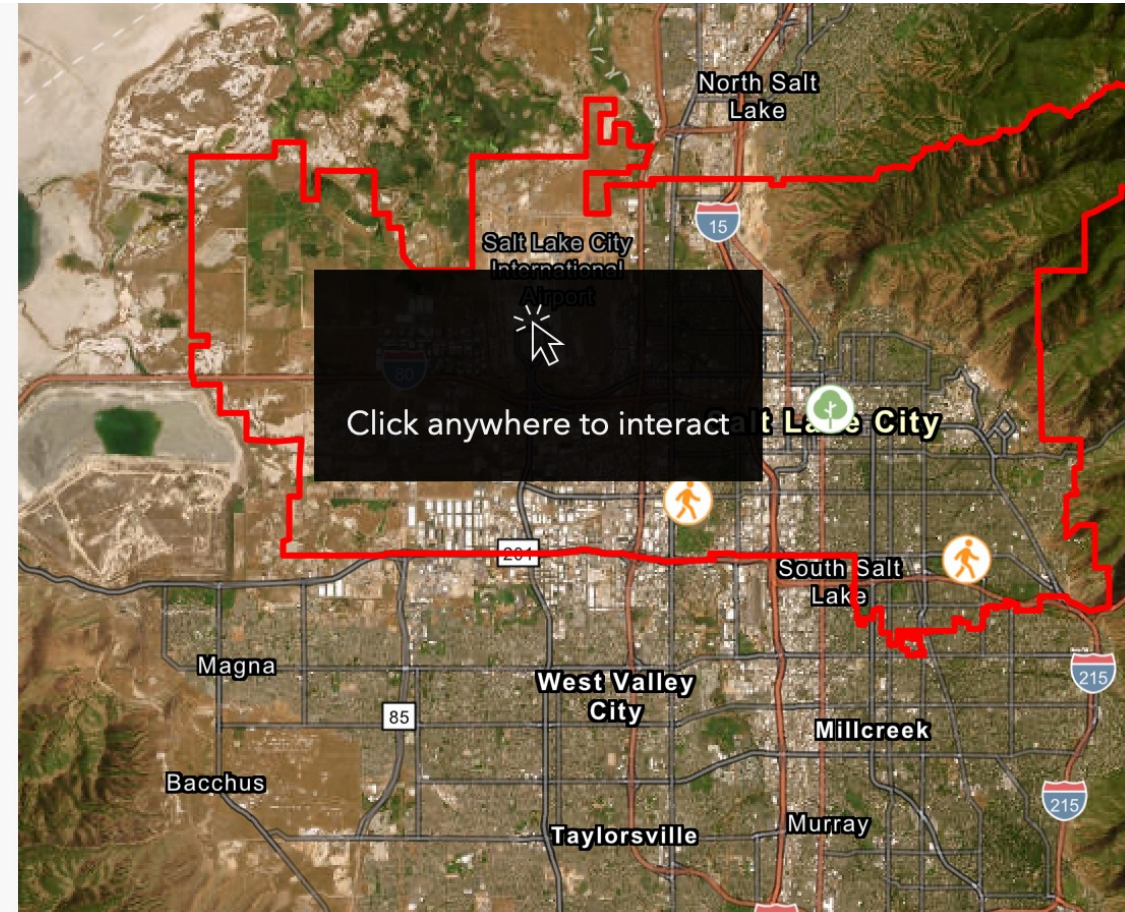
